

Submittal Checklist for

### CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT FOR ALCOHOL SALES

This checklist should be reviewed together with a Planner at the Permit Center and must be submitted with the application. Incomplete applications cannot be processed and will be returned to the applicant together with a checklist specifying the items that are incomplete.

### **MINIMUM SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS:**

Listed below are the minimum submittal requirements for Conditional Use Permits for Alcohol Sales. If there are multiple entitlements, they may be combined under one submittal.

- d) Additional noticing requirements for certain projects:
  - 1) The applicant shall post the on-site posting and City Staff shall mail the hearing notice 28 days prior to the public hearing for projects located in an AD (Alcohol Density) overlay and the application proposes a new bar or tavern, billiard parlor with alcohol service, nightclub with alcohol service or a use which provides for off-site consumption. The hearing notice shall also be mailed to each building occupant within 300 feet of the subject site.
  - 2) City Staff shall post the hearing notice within 1,000 feet of the subject site for all projects with off-site alcohol sales that are adjacent to a residential zoning district.
