I. CALL TO ORDER/INTRODUCTIONS

Commissioner Ayala called the meeting to order at 6:10 pm. Self-introduction of those in attendance took place. Vice Chair Hamilton arrived at approximately 6:20 pm and chaired the meeting.

New commissioner, Karla Bluestone gave brief description of her background.

II. COMMUNITY COMMENTS

Jonathan (no last name given) from District 6 attended the meeting, but had no comments.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Commissioner Dent noted a correction to the date of September's commission meeting in Items 10 and 11 in the minutes of August 15, 2012. Commissioner Martinez asked that the minutes reflect that Director Sanders offered an opportunity for a library commissioner to join the One City, One Story Book Selection Committee in Item 8. She also requested jamaica be written in lower case in Item 10. Commissioner Dent seconded Commissioner Gonzalez's motion to approve the minutes of August 15, 2012, as amended. The motion carried 6-0; Haderlein, Morgan-Hampton, Wang absent.

IV. COMMUNICATIONS

Deputy Director Walker reported that Tuesday, Sept. 25 is National Voter Registration Day to register to vote or to update voter registration information at one of 14 locations throughout the City. Nine of the 14 locations are library branches. Hastings could not participate as it is closed due to remodeling.

V. LIBRARY REPORTS

Summer Reading Club

Librarian Pat Smith reported on the Summer Reading Club. The theme this year was Dream Big! Read! She reported on the goals, format, publicity and statistics of the program. There were 3,919 children who signed up and 194 teens that participated. This was a slight increase in participation overall. No Action Taken.

VI. DEPUTY DIRECTOR'S REPORT

a. Update on Recruitments of the Deputy Director and Head Librarian of Central

Deputy Director Walker reported on the status of the deputy director and head of central positions. The Library is re-opening the deputy director position and is in conversation with Human Resources to get the word out to potential candidates. Beth will return October 9-19 as a contract employee to assist with transition. They should have a decision made for the head of central position by the end of the week.

Commissioner Hamilton asked if the library would consider hiring from within because staff knows the city's history, culture, and what makes Pasadena unique. The library should show more flexibility in requirements and instead consider years of service, she feels. No Action Taken.

b. Report on ArtNight – October 12, 2012

Deputy Director Walker reported on the upcoming library events for ArtNight. Library events will include demonstrations of the "cloud," Kindle, Nook, eBooks and downloadables, the California Poets Festival, plus storytelling, art, music, crafts, and graphic novels. The library will be open from 6-10pm. No Action Taken.
