I wanted to state that I am VERY much opposed to increasing the number of large sporting events at the Rose Bowl from 12 to 25, particularly with the inclusion of NFL events. I live near Fair Oaks between Washington and Mountain. We are already subjected to MULTIPLE disruptive "public events" which increase or divert traffic, including the Marathon, the Black History Month Parade, and the Hispanic Month Parade (all of which block off our sections of streets), not to mention the overflow parking for some of the large Bowl events (such as UCLA-USC games). This does not even include the parking/traffic issues associated with Rose Parade and Rose Bowl.

While I realize we must all take a certain amount of civic responsibility in supporting our city, I feel our neighborhood particularly has had to shoulder an undue burden by all these municipal events.
