CITY OF PASADENA NOTICE OF ANALYSIS OF IMPEDIMENTS TO FAIR HOUSING CHOICE (AI) DRAFT AND PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD ABOUT THE AI

Residents of the City of Pasadena are advised about the availability of the 2012 draft *Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice (AI)*. As a recipient of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), the City of Pasadena is required to submit an "affirmatively further fair housing" (AFFH) certification. As part of the Consolidated Plan, all federal funding grantees are mandated to submit this AFFH certification, which requires them to undertake Fair Housing Planning (FHP) through three steps: 1) Conduct an analysis to identify impediments to fair housing choice within the jurisdiction; 2) Take appropriate actions to overcome the effects of any impediments identified through the analysis; and 3) Maintain records reflecting the analysis and actions taken in this regard.

The AI presents a demographic profile of the City of Pasadena, assesses the extent of fair housing issues among specific groups, and evaluates the availability of a range of housing choices for all residents. The AI also analyzes the conditions in the private market and public sector that may limit the range of housing choices or impede a person's access to housing.
