Replacement of Restroom Buildings at Memorial and Allendale Parks

Please be advised that the City of Pasadena and its contractor, Monet Construction, Inc., will be replacing the existing restroom facilities in Memorial and Allendale Parks with a new restroom facility. The work involves the complete demolition of the existing restroom building and construction of a new restroom facility with vandal-resistant, ADA compliant fixtures, and site improvements including concrete walks and amenities. The new design features durable concrete masonry construction, improved ventilation and energy efficient lighting. Additionally, new storage facilities for Little League, Human Services & Recreation, and Parks & Natural Resources at Allendale Park.

Work hours are Monday through Friday, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Saturday work if needed will be from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. The construction area will be secured with a fence. Please watch for construction vehicles and equipment as they move in and out of the work area.

The City of Pasadena will do its best to minimize disruption caused by the construction. An Inspector from the City's Department of Public Works, wearing a safety vest and a City identification badge, will be present on the job site to answer questions or provide assistance as needed.
