



ABOUT PASADENA


The City of Pasadena is located in Los Angeles County in the northwestern portion of the San Gabriel Valley. The City covers an area of 23 square miles and is bounded on the west by the cities of Los Angeles, Glendale, La Cañada, on the south by South Pasadena and San Marino, on the east by Arcadia and Sierra Madre, and on the north by the unincorporated community of Altadena. The City's population as of January 1, 2014, as reported by the California Department of Finance, is estimated at 140,879 which is a 0.6 percent increase from the previous year (140,020).

Pasadena was incorporated in 1886 and became a charter city in 1901. The City has a council – manager form of government with seven City Council districts each electing a council member for a four-year term. Beginning in May 1999, the Mayor became

an at-large elected position serving a four-year term. The Vice-Mayor is a council member selected by the Council, traditionally for two consecutive one-year terms.

The City Council is responsible for setting policies, passing ordinances, adopting the budget, appointing committees and hiring the City Manager, City Attorney/City Prosecutor and City Clerk. The City Manager is responsible for carrying out policies and ordinances of the City Council, appointing the heads of the City departments and ensuring the successful operation of the City and the three operating companies – Pasadena Center Operating Company, Pasadena Community Access Corporation, and Rose Bowl Operating Company.
