
4. **Tree Removal List:**

The Duarte Chamber of Commerce recognized the Foothill Workforce Investment Board as the 2010-2011 Business of the Year as described in the attached press release.

Phil Dunn, Career Services Division Administrator, supplied the following chart reports figures provided by the California Employment Development Department's Labor Market Information Division. The chart lists unemployment rates over the most recent quarter for Pasadena and other cities and communities that are served by the Foothill Workforce Investment Area. This sub-County level information is not seasonally adjusted. For comparison purposes, the 2010 Annual Unemployment Rate is also listed.

EDD also noted that total non-farm employment in Los Angeles County decreased by 9,500 jobs between May 2011 and June 2011. According to the Employment Development Department's Labor Market Information Division (LMID), the largest month over job reduction occurred in educational and health services. The job loss in educational services resulted from declines in colleges, universities, and professional schools. Other job losses occurred in trade, transportation, and utilities and government. Manufacturing, professional and business services, information, and construction experienced job increases.

According to LMID, County non-farm employment posted a decrease of 15,700 (.41%) between June 2010 and June 2011. Government had the largest cutback, mostly in local and federal government. Trade, transportation and utilities, construction, and financial services also experienced job losses.

Per LMID, the largest year over gain occurred in information, mainly within motion picture and sound recording. Educational and health services also added jobs.

At the national and local levels, unemployment rates are remaining at high levels. After a promising beginning to 2011, the job recovery slowed in May and June. The nation averaged 220,000 new jobs in the February to April period, but added only 54,000 jobs in May and 18,000 in June. A number of one-time factors, including high oil prices, Japan's earthquake and severe weather took their toll on employers. Add government layoffs (particularly in the schools) and the picture is even worse.

With regard to the County, the Los Angeles County Economic Development Corporation projects that the unemployment rate will average 12.2% in 2011 and will stay at about 11.5% in 2012.
